Age Divisions:

Adults: 18+ years Youth: 17 and younger

Standards for Crocheting:

- 1. Crocheted trim: article or structure should reflect the qualities which are desirable or intended for its end use.
- 2. Chain or ring must have even, suitable tension for the article.
- 3. Decrease and increase stitches should be smooth and neat, no holes.
- 4. The correct number of stitches per inch or gauge should be used tension should be uniform.
- Stitches should not be twisted, dropped, or split. Yarn and thread ends should be joined inconspicuously and woven inconspicuously.
- 6. Buttonholes or eyelets evenly spaced, properly placed, and finished. Correct size for button and garment.
- 7. The seam finishes smooth and neat, hand and machine stitching even, carried yarns neat, not too tight.
- 8. Neck finishing or collar, sleeves, armholes, and pockets need to be neat.

EMBROIDERY

Superintendent: Shirlee Martsch

Standards for Embroidery:

- Quality of design, interesting materials and quality of craftsmanship are important.
- 2- Stitches should be even and regular. The selection of thread should be keyed to the type and weight of fabric and appropriate for the design. Stitches should not cause puckering. Tracing of design outlines should not be noticeable.
- 3- An object made from a fabric on which a stitchery design has been worked or an already constructed article which has been decorated with stitchery should be well constructed and suitably presented, cleaned, and framed.
- 4- Knots <u>should not</u> appear on the wrong side; threads <u>should not</u> be carried along the back.


KNITTING

Superintendent: Shirlee Martsch

Standards:

- Reflect the stretch and recovery characteristics of materials and methods used.
- 2- Yarn, needle, techniques used, and design should be suitable to each other and to the obvious end.
- 3- Cast-on and bound-off stitches, even and suitable tension.
- 4- Decrease/increase stitches, neat and smooth. No holes/appropriate method used.
- 5- Gauges correct, tension uniform, stitches not twisted, not dropped, not split.
- 6- Ribbing is even, seam finishes smooth, neat, and flexible.
- 7- Hand and machine stitching even.
- 8- Neck or collar finishing, sleeves and armholes, pockets all need to be neat.
- 9- Carried yarns should be neat and not too tight.
- 10-Blocking: The garment has proper shaping and is smooth.

All items should be entered in a clear plastic bag and must be clean and pressed.

LATCH HOOK

<u>Latch Hook Standards</u> - with bound or finished edges.

- 1- Neatness of technique and careful finishing indicate quality.
- 2- All loose ends should be pulled through the backing to the top surface being trimmed.
- 3- The backing should not show through under the loops.
- 4- If sections are to be joined together, the seams should be flat and smooth.
- 5- General Rules and Home Art Rules apply.

- 4- The projects that are done on canvas should be pressed or blocked; DO NOT OVER PRESS.
