RULES:

1. Student contest open to all *AMATEUR* ceramists.
2. Each article submitted for entry must be the *sole work* of the entrant; teachers may guide and advise only.
3. Each piece must have been made in it's entirety in the past *two years* and never been exhibited at the Minidoka Co. Fair.
4. *All* articles required fired in a ceramic kiln at temperatures exceeding 800 degrees, including "tables and chess boards".
5. Entry tags and master numbers are at the McGregor Building. Fill out correctly with name, date and category.
6. All liability and responsibility for the security of the ceramic pieces or breakage while on the show premises is to be assumed by the exhibitors.
7. Complaints must be registered in writing.
8. Ribbons *may* be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. If three articles or less in a category, article must merit ribbons to receive them.
9. Each person can enter one piece of a set in each class number.
10. No shades on lamps, unless ceramic, should be entered and no electrical hook-up.
11. Judges' decisions are final. No complaints may be made during judging.
12. No Hot glue can be used.
13. All Entrants to abide by the rules.
