Rules:

- 1. Only 24 Entries Per Individual Will Be Allowed. NO one may bring entries in another person's name.
- Please pre-enter at the fair office anytime during the month of July or online at http://minidokacountyfair.fairentry.com/.
 We will take entries on Monday of fair, but there WILL BE A LINE. Please have your paperwork completed.
- 3. You must have duplicate tags: one tag on the item for check-in, and a matching tag to be presented for check-out. (Check-out Sunday 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and Monday from 1:00 To 6:00 pm. Premium checks are available in the fair office during release times.
- 4. Antiques must be 50 years old or older. All exhibits are judged according to age, condition, original appearance, and form. All judge's decisions are final!
- 5. Exhibits must be entered in the appropriate division. Look at the item, look at the division and class number, and enter appropriately. Items not listed may fit in "other class".
- All items exhibited must be washed, dusted, and as clean as possible or they will not be admitted. Judges will not look

- at dirty items. Tape all lids on for safety.
- 7. Jewelry and other small items must be mounted on cardboard (or in baggies, size appropriate).
- 8. No one is to remove any exhibit without ownership and matching duplicate tag. No one is to remove any exhibit without authorization of the superintendent.
- 9. Clothing, linens, etc., entered without plastic covering are left at exhibitor's risk.
- 10. Only the Antique Superintendent and staff are to be in the Antique Building on entry day, judging day, and check out day. This is for the safety of the exhibits.
- 11.Exhibits are required to stay through the fair to check out time.
- 12. Attendants are always on duty in the Antique Building during the fair to keep items safe. However, exhibit your items at your own risk. The Minidoka County Fair Board will not be held liable in case of loss of any kind.
- 13. For each division "A Best of Division" rosette will be given. One "Best of Show" and one "Judge's Choice" (per judge). The rosettes do not pay extra money.
- 14.For safety purposes Post cards, books, documents, and unframed pictures MUST be secured to a piece of cardboard or placed inside a plastic bag. For old documents/pictures, use archival safe plastics.
