- 7. If you are a professional photographer let the superintendent know. Your photos will be judged separately from the amateurs.
- 8. The superintendent reserves the right to divide or make new categories as needed.
- 9. You may enter only TWO pictures in each class number due to limited space. Please choose your best work.
- 10. Age will be considered by the judge.
